Second Tier Market

There were no trades on the Second Tier Market this week.

Mutual Fund Market

Praetorian Property Mutual Fund (PPMF) traded 10,000 shares this week. On the first day of trading the share declined by 1 cent to end at \$4.99, however on the second day of trading it went back up 1 cent to end this week's trading at \$5.00. There were no other trades on this market.

Local Market Summary

Trading activity was down by 17.89 per cent this week as 2,810,722 shares changed ownership compared to last week's volume of 3,423,023 shares. The total value of shares traded was \$15,420,582.82 compared to \$25,692,254.60 last week.

Both Indices ended the week in negative territory as the Composite Index declined 0.13 per cent to 868.1073, while the All T&T Index fell 0.40 per cent to end at 1,078.2359. Advances outnumbered declines with a ratio of 9 to 5.

National Flour Mills (NFM) was the volume leader this week commanding 69.38 per cent of the market with a total volume of 1,950,185. National Commercial Bank Jamaica (NCBJ) followed with a total volume of 192,512 shares changing ownership or 6.85 per cent of all trades. Sagicor Financial Corporation was next trading 141,732 shares or 5.04 per cent of the market.

NFM was also the major advance this week, climbing 20 cents or 12.12 per cent to \$1.85. PLIPDECO (PLD) was the second major advance this week ending at \$5.01 after moving up 51 cents or 11.33 per cent on last week's close. Angostura Holdings Limited (AHL) followed as the third major advance up 25 cents or 6.25 per cent to \$4.25.

The largest decline of the week belonged to Prestige Holdings Limited (PHL), which fell 48 cents or 9.60 per cent to \$4.52. This movement in price came after the release of the Company's third quarter results in which Earnings were down by 19.45 per cent (Nine Months 2005 on Nine Months 2006). However, Q3 2005 on Q3 2006 showed a slight improvement- as the Earnings figure was up by 1 per cent. The second largest decline was L J Williams- 'B' (LJWB), which dropped 5 cents or

3.85 per cent to end the week at \$1.25. While RBTT Financial Holdings Limited (RBTT) was the third major decline for the week falling 85 cents or 3.07 per cent to \$26.85.

Jamaica Stock Exchange (JSE)

In Jamaica, trading volumes were up to more normal levels this week, as 16,493,955 shares changed ownership compared to last week's total of 9,096,541. The total value of shares traded was JMD257,079,289.32 compared to the previous week's value of JMD81,256,707.

Indices ended in mixed territory this week, as the Market Index and Select Index fell by 0.37 per cent to 86,319.97

and 0.07 per cent to 2,357.28, respectively. While the All Jamaican Composite climbed 0.16 per cent to 87,417.69. Jamaica Broilers (JBG) was the volume leader with 4,083,017 shares (24.75%) changing ownership followed by Cable and Wireless Jamaica (CWJA) with 2,940,365 shares (17.83%) and Jamaica Producers Group (JP) with 2,156,260 shares (8.58%).

Overall market activity resulted in 17 shares advancing and 12 shares declining. Ciboney Group Limited (CBNY) was the major advance for the week, moving up 50.00 per cent to JMD0.06. While Trinidad Cement Limited (TCL) was the major decline, dropping 20.43 per cent to JMD65.25.
