EQUITY SUMMARY

Trinidad and Tobago

Trading activity fell this week with 778,519 shares traded on the First Tier Market, a decline of 38.78 per cent on last week's volume of 1,271,656 shares. The value of shares traded also fell this week, down 26.64 per cent from \$20,951,990.41 last week to \$15,369,514.96 this week. First Citizens Bank Limited (FIRST) was the volume leader with 39.76 per cent of all trades or 309,552 shares traded.

This week, the Composite Index closed at 1,146.58, down 0.07 per cent or 0.75 points, the All Trinidad and Tobago Index fell 0.11 per cent or 2.20 points to 1,946.25 and the Cross Listed Index advanced 0.20 per cent or 0.09 points to 45.52. Advances outnumbered declines by a ratio of 6 to 5. This week's top performer was Jamaica Money Market Brokers Group Limited (JMMBGL), which posted a 2.38 per cent gain from \$0.42 to \$0.43. The major decline was National Enterprises Limited (NEL), down 1.07 per cent or \$0.18 to \$16.72.



There was no activity on the Second Tier Market this week. On the TTD Mutual Fund Market, 114,635 CLICO Investment Fund (CIF) units traded with a value of \$2,580,211.20. CIF's price remained unchanged at \$22.51.
