EQUITY SUMMARY

Trinidad and Tobago

This week a total of 1,521,017 shares traded on the First Tier Market, down 31.99 per cent on last week's volume of 2,236,453 shares. The value of shares traded fell 23.70 per cent from \$34,307,698.99 last week to \$26,177,638.73 this week. The volume leader was National Enterprises Limited (NEL) accounting for 25.02 per cent of all trades this week with 380,625 shares traded.

All three Indices closed higher this week. The Composite Index climbed 0.73 per cent or 8.08 points to end at 1,115.33, the All Trinidad and Tobago Index inched up 0.54 per cent or 9.49 points to 1,761.94 and the Cross Listed Index gained 1.46 per cent or 0.90 points to close at 62.36.



The major advance was National Commercial Bank Jamaica Limited (NCBJ), rising 4.00 per cent or \$0.10 to close the week at \$2.60 and the major decline was L.J. Williams 'B' Limited (LJWB), down 3.12 per cent or \$0.03 to \$0.93. Advances outnumbered declines by a ratio of 8 to 5.

There was no activity on the Second Tier Market this week. On the TTD Mutual Fund Market 214,529 CLICO Investment Fund (CIF) units traded with a value of \$4,849,794.50. CIF's price fell 0.18 per cent or \$0.04 to \$22.61.
